"Scurra" could be translated as "admirable spirit" in Latin. We are a band of minstrels who offer a festive and acoustic music, tinted of medieval inspiration. Mixing folk instruments such as violin, tin whistle, guitar and bodhrán with simple or polyphonic singing, Scurra proposes you to discover a great repertoire of melodies and songs, borrowed from the european medieval tradition to more modern pieces, that the band adapts, transforms and rewrites, to satisfy enthusiasts of fairs, dance, and medieval times.

The band can adapt to different types of events. We can play in strolls, distilling our music and our energy directly with those who wish to share our good vibes (small concerts, in mobility, distributed over the day, interspersed with pauses that number and frequency should be established according to the specificity of your event).

We can also perform on stage, for performances ranging from 45 min to 1h30, and requiring the provision of sound equipment by the organizers.

Scurra is also a troupe that can offer multidisciplinary performances. As such, our shows can include juggling, fire manipulations, tales and dance depending on your needs and our availabilities.
